

Kid of the Week Contest

Official Rules

No Purchase Necessary.

1. **Eligibility Restrictions:** Participation in the “Kid of the Week” Contest (the “Contest”) as a nominator (“Nominator”) is open only to legal U.S. citizens and residents of Illinois, 14 years old or older. Participation in the Contest as a nominated child (“Child”) is open only to legal U.S. citizens and residents of Illinois, who are nine to 18 years old. A Child may nominate himself/herself, so long as the Child is 14-18 years old, in which case the Child will also be the Nominator. Employees (and their immediate family members or members of the same household) of WGN Radio (“Sponsor”), Tribune Media Company, any other sponsor, their respective parent companies, subsidiaries, and affiliates and the advertising agencies and other third parties involved with the creation or administration of this Contest are not eligible to participate. For purposes of this Contest, the phrase immediate family member includes spouse, parents, siblings, and children. This Contest is void where prohibited and outside Illinois.

2. **To Submit a Nomination:** The entry period for the Contest begins January 16, 2018 at 10:00 am CT and will continue until WGN Radio posts notice of termination on the station’s contest page (the “Entry Period”). The Contest will be divided into weekly periods (each, a “Week”). Except for the first Week, which will begin on January 16, 2018 at 10 am CT, each Week begins on Tuesday at 12:01 am CT and ends that Sunday at 11:59 pm CT. WGN Radio listeners will be invited to visit WGN Radio’s website’s contest page (www.wgnradio.com/contests) and submit a nomination (the “Nomination”) for a Child to be the “Kid of the Week.” Nominators must complete all required fields in the Nomination form, including Nominator’s name, email address, and phone number, the Child’s name, age and school (if known), the name and phone number of the Child’s parent or legal guardian and confirm both the Nominator and the Child are residents of Illinois. The Nominator must also submit an essay of 150 words or less about why the nominated Child should be selected as “Kid of the Week” (the “Essay”). Essays should describe how the Child goes above and beyond for his/her community, has performed a good Samaritan act, made academic or athletic accomplishments, or engaged in positive behavior in the classroom or home life, and the Essay must include an example of such acts within the six months immediately preceding submission of the Nomination. A Child may nominate himself/herself if the Child is 14 years old or older, but under no circumstances may a child under 14 submit his or her personal information. Nominations may be submitted at any time within the Entry Period. Only one Nomination per Nominator will be permitted during the Entry Period (although multiple Nominations from different Nominators nominating the same Child are permitted). Non-winning Nominations will carry over from one Week to the next until the Contest is terminated. Nominators must use their own name. If any dispute arises concerning the identity of a Nominator, the authorized account holder of the email account identified in the Nomination form for the Nominator will be deemed the Nominator. The “authorized account holder” is the natural person assigned an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted address. Nominator of potential winner may be required to show proof of being the authorized account holder. The Nominator must not submit any contact information for the Child, unless the Child is nominating himself/herself. Nominations containing attached files are not eligible and will be rejected. Sponsors are not responsible for lost, incomplete, damaged, illegible, late, or misdirected Nominations, or for errors in mechanical transmission, technical difficulties or inability to transmit Internet Nominations.

3. **Submitted Materials:** The Essay must be in English. The Essay must not portray any dangerous activity; must not disparage Sponsors must not contain material that is inappropriate, indecent, lewd, pornographic, obscene, hateful, tortious, defamatory, slanderous or libelous; must not contain material that promotes bigotry, racism, hatred or harm against any group or individual or promotes discrimination based on race, gender, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation or age; and must not contain material that is unlawful, in violation of, or contrary to the laws or regulations in any jurisdiction where the Essay is created. By submitting a Nomination, the Nominator represents and warrants that the Nominator has all rights necessary to submit the Essay, and that the Essay has not been previously published, does

not violate the rights of any other person or company (including but not limited to privacy and copyrights), does not defame, libel, or slander anyone or any entity, does not contain inappropriate, offensive, indecent, vulgar, obscene or profane content, and in no other way violates any applicable laws, as determined by Sponsors. Nominations that do not comply with these Official Rules or the foregoing representations and warranties will be disqualified, and Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any Nomination at any time that in Sponsors' opinion does not comply with these Official Rules. Each Nominator agrees to indemnify, defend and hold Sponsors harmless against any and all liabilities, losses, damages, claims, debts, investigations, fines, penalties, costs, expenses and settlements (including attorneys' fees and costs of litigation, settlement, judgment, interest and penalties) arising out of or related to a breach of the foregoing representations and warranties.

By submitting a Nomination, each Nominator grants to the Tribune Broadcasting Company, LLC, its affiliates and entities, including Sponsor, and its affiliated Web sites and broadcast stations a world-wide, royalty-free, perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive right and fully sub-licensable license to use, copy, reproduce, distribute, publish, publicly perform, publicly display, modify, adapt, translate, archive, store, and create derivative works from his/her Essay in any form, format, or medium, of any kind now known or later developed, without prior notice, approval or compensation. Nominators further grant rights in their Essay as set forth in the Terms of Service on the Contest Website. Nominators otherwise will retain all rights to their respective Essays.

4. **Kid of the Week Selection:** One Child will be selected as the Kid of the Week for each Week until the Contest is terminated, and judging will occur periodically throughout the Entry Period and immediately thereafter. A Nomination is eligible for a particular drawing if it was received prior to the selection deadline, if it otherwise meets the eligibility criteria set forth in these Official Rules, and if it has not previously been chosen as a winner. A panel of judges will award points for eligible Nominations based on demonstrated merit of the Child's accomplishments (50%) and human-interest appeal (50%). The Nomination that is awarded the most points for each Week will be declared the potential winner, and the Child nominated in such Nomination will be declared the potential "Kid of the Week" (which will be subject to confirmation of Nominator and Child eligibility and compliance with these Official Rules) for that Week. If there is a tie for first, the judges will re-judge the tied Nominations to determine the Kid of the Week.

5. **Kid of the Week Notification and Verification:** Sponsors will attempt to notify the winning Nominator and the parent or legal guardian of the winning Child (if the Child did not nominate himself/herself) by email and/or telephone. The parent or legal guardian of the potential winning Child must provide written permission accepting the nomination of the Child as a condition of participating in the Contest. If selected as the Kid of the Week, the Nominator (and parent or legal guardian of Nominator who is 18 or younger) and Child (and parent or legal guardian of Child) may be required to sign and return a release and waiver of liability and may also be required to sign a release of the Essay, Appearance (defined below), and Video (defined below). If a selected Nominator or Child is later determined to be ineligible, or if the parent or legal guardian of Child and the Nominator (if the Child did not nominate himself/herself) fail to respond within 48 hours of initial notification attempt, or if the parent or legal guardian of the winning Child declines to participate in the Contest or fails to timely provide written permission for the Child's continued participation, or if the Nominator or Child refuses to participate in the Appearance, or if the Nominator (and parent or legal guardian of Nominator who is 18 or younger) or Child (and parent or legal guardian) fails to provide required identification or to sign and return required documents, then that Nominator and the corresponding Child will be disqualified. In such event, the Nomination with the next-highest score (as determined by the judges) will be tentatively declared the winner (time permitting), subject to eligibility confirmation and compliance with these Official Rules, and further subject to fulfilling the participation conditions described herein. The names of both the winning Nominator and the winning Child may be announced on-air, and may be posted on WGN Radio's Contest website. A Kid of the Week will be named for each Week, provided a sufficient number of eligible Nominations are received.

6. **Prize/On-Air Appearances:** Prizes will be awarded to each Kid of the Week winner. The value of prizes will range from \$25 to \$100. Each Kid of the Week (and their respective Nominators) will be required to appear on the Steve Cochran Show (the "Show") either live or via audiotape (the "Appearance"). The Appearance of the Kid of the Week and his/her Nominator may also be videotaped (the "Video"). The Appearance and Video may also appear on the WGN website, apps, and social media channels. The Appearance will either occur via telephone or in the WGN Radio Showcase Studio or another WGN Radio studio. Sponsor will determine the location of the Appearance. There is no dollar value for the Appearance or Video. WGN Radio will provide notification to the parent/legal guardian of the Child and to the Nominator of the date and time for the Appearance. For in-studio Appearances, the Child, Nominator, and parent/legal guardian of the Child must arrive at the station by at least half an hour before each scheduled Appearance. The parent/legal guardian must accompany the Child at all times during the Appearance. Please note that if there is severe weather or breaking news, the Appearance may be cancelled. WGN Radio will attempt to notify Nominator and the parent/legal guardian of the Child in advance, but cancellations frequently happen without notice. If WGN Radio cancels the Appearance, WGN Radio will attempt to reschedule but cannot guarantee that there will be an open date on the calendar. Costs of transportation and accommodations, where applicable and any other cost or services not specifically included in the prize are the sole responsibility of the winners. The opportunity to appear on the Show is not an offer of employment, the Nominator represents and warrants that Nominator's Appearance (if applicable) will not violate any union or guild agreement, and the parent/legal guardian of the Child represents and warrants that Child's Appearance will not violate any union or guild agreement. Winning Nominator and Child will be required to comport with generally accepted standards of behavior for an on-air appearance. Federal, state, and local taxes, if any, are the sole responsibility of prize recipients. Sponsor will determine the mode of prize delivery at its sole discretion and may require winners to claim prizes at the WGN Radio studios. Unless otherwise indicated by Sponsor or its prize suppliers, prizes are non-transferable, non-negotiable and not redeemable for cash, credit or merchandise. No prize substitutions except at Sponsor's sole discretion. All properly claimed prizes will be awarded, but in no event will Sponsor award more prizes than are provided for in these Official Rules.

7. **Internet:** If for any reason the Internet-related portion of this Contest is not capable of running as planned, including infection by computer virus, tampering, fraud, technical failure, or any other cause, that corrupts, interrupts or threatens the administration, security or integrity of the Contest, Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to terminate or suspend the Contest or any portion thereof. If Sponsor terminates the Contest, Sponsor will select the Kids of the Week through termination as set forth above but will not select any additional Kids of the Week. Sponsor will announce any such termination on the Contest website and on the Show. Sponsor will use information submitted in Nominations in accordance with its Privacy Policy.

8. **Conditions:** Except where prohibited by law, by submitting a Nomination, each Nominator grants permission, without further compensation, to Sponsor and its agents and licensees, to use the Nominator's name, voice, photograph, likeness, and biographical material for broadcast and promotional purposes in connection with the Contest, in any media. By submitting a Nomination, each Nominator agrees to release Sponsor, Tribune Media Company, and their respective parents, affiliates, and subsidiaries and all of their employees, officers, and directors from any claim, loss, liability, damage or injury of any kind arising from the Nominator's participation in the Contest or receipt or use of a prize. Nominators agree to be bound by these Official Rules, and by submitting a Nomination, agree that all decisions regarding eligibility, the administration of this Contest, and the award of Contest prizes made by Sponsor will be final and binding. Sponsor reserves the right to prohibit any Nominator or Child from participating in the Contest and reject the Nomination if, at its sole discretion, Sponsor finds such Nominator or Child to be tampering with the Nomination process or the operation of the Contest, or if such Nominator or Child shows a disregard for, or attempts to circumvent, these Official Rules, or acts: (a) in a manner the Sponsor determines to be not fair or equitable; (b) in an annoying, threatening, or harassing manner; or (c) in any other disruptive manner. If a dispute arises regarding compliance with these Official Rules, Sponsor may consider, in its sole discretion, data reasonably available to Sponsor through information technology systems in Sponsor's control, but Sponsor will not be obligated to consider any data or other information collected from any other source. Sponsor assumes no liability for (a) any incorrect or inaccurate Nomination information; or (b) any unauthorized access to, or theft,

destruction or alteration of Nominations at any point in the operation of this Contest. Neither the failure of Sponsor to insist upon or enforce strict performance of any provision of these Official Rules nor the failure, delay or omission by Sponsor in exercising any right with respect to any term of these Official Rules, will be construed as a waiver or relinquishment to any extent of Sponsor's right to assert or rely upon any such provision or right in that or any other instance. If there is any conflict between the terms of these Official Rules and any advertising or marketing materials used in connection with the Contest, the terms of the Official Rules will govern.

As a condition of submitting a Nomination, Nominators agree: (a) under no circumstances will Nominator be permitted to obtain awards for, and Nominator hereby waives all rights to claim punitive, incidental, consequential, or any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses; (b) all causes of action arising out of or related to this Contest, or any prize awarded, will be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the appropriate court in Cook County, Illinois, to which Nominator submits to personal jurisdiction; and (c) any and all claims, judgments, and awards will be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, excluding attorneys' fees and court costs. Some jurisdictions do not allow for limitations on the ability to pursue class action remedies, or certain kinds of damages, and so these limitations may not apply to you. This Contest will be governed and enforced pursuant to Illinois law, excluding choice of law provisions.

10. **Winners List:** For a Winners List, send a self-addressed stamped envelope labeled "Kid of the Week Contest" to 435 N. Michigan Ave. Chicago, IL 60611. All requests must be mailed separately. Requests for winners' lists must be received within 30 days of the end of the Entry Period.
